- There is an issue with the Wednesday 7:00 PM Newsline rebroadcast, it seems we re-broadcast Newsline at the same time as other repeaters in the area at and the question was asked if we should move our time so that all of the local repeaters are not tied up at the same time. Nathan (N8THN) will work with the other repeater organizations on timing and changes.
- The IFR has been repaired and is ready for use. A problem was brought to the boards attention that the repair costs \$2000, and we do not have \$2000 to cover the cost. A great deal of frustration was expressed about the lack of communication regarding this repair and the lack of board notification or approval of this expense. Additionally it is not known who covered the cost of the repair, someone named Andy may have payed the bill from the repair

facility. This expense will endanger our ability to cover our expenses in for the first quarter.

- There was a discussion on a possible fund raiser, maybe something at a restaurant like the KC SAR team did last week at Moes. Del (W8WDW) will continue to explore this possibility.
